

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
REGARDING CLOSED ASSOCIATE FACULTY LISTS**

**June 1, 2010**

In recognition of the fact that the certain disciplines exceed the 60% rule for Associate Faculty status as outlined in 6.6.2, the District and the Faculty Association agree as follows:

For The Disciplines Of Counseling, Mathematics, Spanish, Psychology, Accounting, Computer Information Systems, Japanese, Chinese, French, Italian, Cosmetology, Political Science, History, Photography, Sociology, Economics, American Sign Language, Film Studies, English, Music, Philosophy, Computer Science, Office Technology and Nutrition:

1. **THE LISTS ARE CLOSED** : For Spring, 2010, the Associate Faculty lists for the aforementioned disciplines are closed to any newly identified Associate Faculty.
2. **HOLD HARMLESS** : Should any additional faculty come to light who would have had Associate Faculty status on or before Spring, 2010 but were, due to reporting errors, not listed as such in the District database systems, Associate Faculty status will be granted to them, regardless of the list being closed in their discipline.
3. **FUTURE REVIEW** : The Associate Faculty list shall be reviewed again by the Academic Affairs office and the Faculty Association in Spring, 2011 after Spring Break.

Solely For The Disciplines Of Counseling, Mathematics, Spanish, Psychology, Accounting, Computer Information Systems, Japanese, Chinese, French, Italian, Cosmetology, Political Science, History, Photography, Economics, American Sign Language and Sociology:

4. **STATUS AWARDING WITHHELD** : Certain Faculty were eligible to receive Associate Faculty status in Spring, 2009 or Spring, 2010 in disciplines whose lists have been closed. Either the discipline currently exceeds the 60% limit or would exceed the 60% limit with these newly qualified faculty. These faculty shall remain eligible to receive Associate Faculty status in Spring, 2011 regardless of their assigned load in Fall, 2010 or Spring, 2011. These faculty are listed below.
